

- "I heard a lot of yelling 'Code Blue' and assumed it was the cops"
- "The fire alarm went off"
- "We were in the classroom until 115pm"
- When asked how long the above referenced time was in relation to hearing the gunshots, she stated maybe "30 minutes"
- She thought she heard the gunshot "probably !240pm"





- Stated she was in the science wing, Room W105, in a chemistry class "taking a quiz"
- She stated the class started at approximately "1215pm"
- · She stated they were "10 minutes into quiz" when "I heard a bang"
- "I thought it was a science experiment"
- "I stood up and looked outside (classroom door)"
- · She recalled seeing two girls sitting on a bench doing what she thought was "homework"
- "I saw one girl slumped over"
- · "After the 2nd bang, I saw another girl fall on top of her"
- "I saw some smoke"
- . "I assumed he came in from the West or South doors" or the entrance doors that were nearest the classroom
- I asked why she thought the person was a "he" she replied "I dunno, I just assumed"
- She denied seeing the suspect.
- · She said the teacher "locked the doors" and "turned the lights off"
- She heard yelling "Which way did he go?" and "Who is it?"
- She stated she was in the classroom until approximately 230p.

#### NARRATIVE:

On 12/13/13 at approximately 1508 hours I was notified by Trooper Marty Smith that dispatch was requesting troopers to respond to Arapahoe High School to assist with a school shooting that occurred earlier in the day. Trooper Smith advised dispatch that I would be in route. While in route, Major Savage advised me to respond to the command post near the Burger King at the intersection of South University Boulevard and East Dry Creek Road.

I arrived at the command post at approximately 1600 hours. I then contacted Major Savage, who stated that they did not have an assignment for me at that time. Major Savage advised me to stand by at the command post for an assignment. Later Major Savage stated that our extra assistance was no longer needed. At approximately 1626 hours I cleared from the scene.

## SUMMARY:

IARY: On Friday December 13, 2013, at approximately 1500 hours, Sgt. Beaudin advised me to respond to Euclid Middle School to assist with the Arapahoe High School shooting investigation.

Once I arrived at Euclid Middle School I was instructed to assist with interviews of witnesses of the event.

My first interview was with **sector and the sector of the** 

- She was in Spanish class room C21, so she did not see anything just heard things.
- She heard what she thought was a locker slam or trash can bang. She then heard another quick follow up "bang".
- · She then heard what she thought may have been three more shots for a total of five shots.
- · At this time her Spanish teacher got up locked the door and turned the lights off.
- · She then heard lots of yelling, but was unsure exactly what was being said.
- She thought she heard "shooter" but was unsure.
- It sounded like "people of authority" arrived quickly.
- The fire alarm then started going off but they were instructed to stay in the classroom over the intercom.

I then asked **setup** if she had heard any rumors of anyone being upset or planning to do something like this. **Setup** stated that she heard on Wednesday a kid banged on a class room door and demanded to be let in. Once the kid entered the classroom the kid yelled at the teacher. **Setup** stated she did not know which kid or class room was involved in this incident.

My second interview was with **second second** (**second second**). **Second** stated the following during her interview:

- · She was in Mr. Lutz science class at the time. She was unsure what room number it was.
- She also did not see anything just heard stuff.

- · The police then came and escorted her class out.

I then asked **sector** if she had heard any rumors before or after the event. **Sector** stated that she only heard that the shooter was mad at a teacher. She did not know what teacher or what student. **Sector** stated she did not hear any rumors prior to the event.

I was then instructed to respond to Arapahoe High School to debrief. After debriefing my interviews I cleared the scene.

This concludes my involvement in this case.



On 12-14-2013 at approximately 1200hrs I was off duty and having lunch with my wife at the Black Eyed hea restaurant, located at S Broadway and Littleton Blvd. After finishing kunch with her I dropped her off at Schemp Honda and drove South on S Broadway going back to Highlands Ranch. I was approaching Dry Creek 8d and 5 Broadway when I observed numerous police cars from different agencies driving code and headed East on Dry Creek Rd. I then got a text message from my wife stating there was an active shooter at Arapahoe High School. I immediately drove through the red light at Dry Creek Rd and S Broadway and drove to Arapahoe High School approximately 1 mile from my location. As I drove into the area I asked an unknown fire fighter who was rushing to the scene where the police command post was? He stated that it was at the corner of 5 University and Dry Creek Rd. I then drove through the Southern neighborhood of the school and made my way to the South East corner of the school, I arrived on scene at approxin," taly 1250hrs, I parked my truck with numerous other marked and unmarked units, edited my vehicle and began to grab my active shooter gear. As I was getting my gear ready, numerous other plain clothecipilities arrived at the same time and began to deploy. I grabbed my duty rifie, active shooter bag and placed numerous rifle magazines in my pockets. I had no builet proof vest with me so i put on an APD ID west to make myself known to other agencies. Once ready I asked the other officers setting ready where the command post was? One of them stated that it was at the Chase bank/Burger King on the Northeast corner of 5 University and Dry Creek Rd. I immediately sprinted across the intersection and made my way to the command post. Several other agancy officers and f arrived at command post at the same time. I identified myself to the commanding officer and asked him where he needed me? He placed me with the other 3 officers that arrived at same time and told us we were needed in the school because there were student still inside. The other 3 officers and I sprinted across the street to the Southside of the school. As we approached the school, I could see dozens and sozens of students running out of the school heading south. As ) got to the South side an unknown female Arapahoe County deputy yelled at me that she needed help inside the school. I then ran to her location and entered the school through a Southside door. Once inside, I observed numerous officers moving and taking up key hole positions in a main hallway. I stopped and esked an Arapahoe County deputy what they needed help with? One of the deputies stated that there was a shooter down in the library and that he had an explosive device with him. He then stated that they didn't know if there were any other explosives in the school. As I was getting briefed by the deputy another deputy statud that the science pod had not been cleared and that there were students trapped in their class rooms. We formed a FAST beam and began moving toward the science pod. The deputy was in front of me leading the team and there with several other officers from other jurisdictions behind me. As we made our way down the hallway we rounded a corner and came to the library, the deputy in front of me bagan yalling "watch your step there is bidhd'ori the floor". I observed heavy blood splatter and pools of blood all over the floor. We then came to the main entrance to the science pod on our left side. Several officers kept moving straight and crossed in front of the open doors of the science pod which was supposed to be unsecured and not cleared. I felt this was threat area and stapped across the hallway and took a position at the open doors of the science pod, covering the efficers that were moving behind me. Several other officers joined in bahind me and I lead them into the science pod hellway clearing the rooms on the left side. We came to an intersecting hallway where numerous other officers joined us

Afterwards, he was released to his mother and the statement was given to the Arapahoe County Sheriff's investigator who was in the chapel.

I remained at the location until we were released from the scene.

University Blvd. This location once secured was to be used to relocate a portion of the students from the high school.

I assisted other officer's in securing the perimeter of the church and was able to locate my daughter at that facility. I then turned over my position to another officer and removed my daughter from the scene.

This concluded my involvement.

At approximately 1315 hours I was contacted by FPS Agent Dave Tyndall to have our Bomb K9 Unit respond to an Active Shooter/Bomb threat, which had occurred at Arapahoe High School, 2201 E Dry Creek Rd, Centennial, CO. The following is a break down of our involvement in the incident:

1315 - Received request from FPS Agent Dave Tyndall for assistance with an Active shooter/Bomb threat, which had occurred at Arapahoe High School. Contacted D/S Hynes to also respond, and called Capt. Bruning to inform him of the situation.

1345 - D/S Hynes/K9 Taylor arrived on scene Tasked by Sgt R. Anselmi ASC Bomb Squad to assist with clearing north parking lot. Standby until 1445 swept Media Center and 5 rooms adjacent (Suspect Body located). Completed at 1505 no alerts or behavior

1350- D/S Swan/K9 Rex arrived and assigned with FPS Agent Tyndall to sweep the half circle south side of building for student evacuations. 1415-1435 swept with no alerts or behavior changes. 1440 assigned with FBI Bomb Tech to sweep cafeteria area for staging of follow on SWAT teams. Completed at 1500 no alerts or behavior changes 50 back packs 8 rooms cleared.

1500-1600 Standby Chase Bank Command Post. Map of school provided areas of responsibilities assigned.

1620- D/S Swan/K9 Rex assigned with ASC Bomb Tech begin sweep of area A2. 1810-A2 completed no alerts or behavior change from Rex. 100++ back packs and 15+ rooms searched.

1500 - D/S Hynes/K9 Taylor assigned ASC Bomb Tech and began sweep of area A5. 1900-A5 completed no alerts or behavior change from Taylor. 100++ back packs and 15+ rooms searched.

The below are notes provided by the special agents documenting their activity:

### SA wrote:

A. approximately 1320 hours Special Agent (SA) U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Homeland Security Investigations, arrived near the intersection of University and Dry Creek in Centennial, Colorado. On arrival noted a uniform officer from Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department SA moving students and other persons across University to the opposite side of the road from Arapahoe High School. SA also observed HSI SA had arrived at 1310 hours. SA arriving to the same location. SA approached the officer and asked what could be done to assist and if a command post was established. The officer stated the command post was across the street in the Albertson's parking lot and officers needed assistance with moving students. At approximately 1325 hours while assisting moving students across the street, SA observed another HSI agent who identified himself as At approximately 1326 hours, uniform officers on University indicated that assistance was needed with evacuating students from SA the school on the north side of the building by the track. and SA responded to this location and assisted officers on the track. SA assisted in student pat-downs and subsequent evacuation from the track to school buses on the west side of the school. During pat-downs, SA noted a student complaining of difficulty breathing and stated that he needed his inhaler and escorted student to a uniformed officer who subsequently radioed for medical assistance. SA hoted that the student was escorted by the officer from the north side of the school to medical personnel on University. 
On December 13, 2013 at about 1245 hours I responded to an active shooter call at Arapahoe County High School. While en-route I called Detectives known to me as being off duty and asked them be ready to respond. On arrival I met with Lt. McCarty and together we organized a response from DCSO Detectives to assist on this call in any manner needed.

At 1430 hours, and from the request of Lt. McCarty, I directed Detectives Dave Weaver and Kevin Bechert to respond to **Exercise Control** (Littleton, Douglas County CO) to assist with holding the residence as I was told the residence could be that of the suspected shooter. I was then directed to respond to Euclid Middle School (777 West Euclid Avenue) to assist with witness interviews.

I arrived at Euclid Middle School at 1445 hours and was directed to the gymnasium where students from ACHS were being taken via bus. The gymnasium was separated into two quadrants where those believed to be witnesses were separated from those who were not.

#### The following are statements from those students who stated they were witnesses.


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

# INVESTIGATOR'S PROGRESS REPORT SHERIFF'S OFFICE DOUGLAS COUNTY

CR# 2013-00114450 CASE TYPE: Agency Assist INVESTIGATOR ASSIGNED: Lt. Tommy Barrella

On 12/13/13 I responded to Arapahoe High School upon hearing dispatch advise that the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office was requesting assistance for an active shooter. While enroute I saw/did the following:

- Advised the deputies working the School Marshall Program to remain in the county so our schools would be covered.
- Spoke to Lt. Cataffo via phone where we discussed a game plane to insure there was coverage in the County as well as managing our staff at the scene.
- Responded to the NW parking lot of the school to see if there were other law enforcement members to meet up with to form an element. There were no other officers so I took up a perimeter position.

Upon arriving on scene I saw/did the following:

- Heard assistance was needed at the intersection of Dry Creek Road and N. University Blvd.
- Responded to that intersection and advised the other officers on scene we would be shutting this intersection down in all directions.
- Was advised by Chief Nicholson-Kluth we would be routing the cars we had to the East and then closing down the intersection farther east and south.
- The intersections to the North and West were already taken care of.
- Directed family members to the reunification locations.
- Was requested to assist as a Bomb Technician.

In my Bomb Tech role I did the following:

- Responded back to the NW corner of the school to meet up with a member of the Arapahoe Bomb Squad.
- Was advised we would look for the suspect vehicle and deal with it accordingly.
- Located the vehicle and took no action as there was nothing of concern in view.
- Assisted with patting down the students that were leaving on the south side of the school to head toward the Starbucks for a bus.
- Was assigned to the FBI Tactical Team to assist them with clearing a portion of the school
- Responded back to the Command Post for new assignment and direction.
- Took control of our Bomb Squad Technicians who had also been assigned to other teams for the initial sweep.

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- Met up with Lt. McMillan and the SWAT Team to perform another sweep of the West end of the school.
- Was advised to respond back to the Command Post for reassignment.

Was advised I needed to take our Bomb Squad down to the suspect's residence to assist the ATF and Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office with searching the residence.

Upon arriving at the address I saw/did the following:

- Investigations had the house taped off with crime scene tape.
- Members of the ATF were still on scene
- Was advised ATF forced entry due to exigency.
- They did not see anything on their safety sweep but noticed a strong odor of gasoline so they left they front door open.
- Waited for ACSO Invest to respond with the search warrant and give us permission to do a slower sweep of the house for any booby traps or suspicious devices.
- Cleared the house with other members of the DCSO Bomb Squad and two ATF Agents.
- No devices or booby traps were located.
- Turned house over to ACSO Invest and remained on scene to assist them if needed.

#### 1241 Hours:

I was the Watch Commander for DCSO Day Shift and was advised that ASCO was requesting mutual aid for an active shooter at the high school located on University and Dry Creek at which time I did the following:

- Ordered all available day shift patrol respond to the school to assist.
- Ordered that all Douglas County Schools be placed on lockout
- Ordered that all swing shifts report to work immediately and remain in the county.
- Requested dispatch work on patching radio communications with ASCO.
- Advised Capt, Weekly of what had taken place.

All school marshal deputies and other traffic deputies were told to remain in Douglas County by Lt. Barrella who was also responding.

I responded to Arapahoe County High School and DCSO deputies had arrived and were preparing entry teams to enter the school.

I did the following during the incident:

- I met with fire command in the strip mall directly across from the high school and began
  gathering information regarding the incident, and was informed that the shooter had killed
  himself but it was not known if other shooters were still in the building.
- School staff approached me and provided me with the name of the suspected shooter, Karl Pierson and I took a picture of the school document and emailed it to Chief Kluth and Capt. Kennedy. (see attached)
- I had DOW officers, CSP troopers and Denver Public School Security officers at my location and had them remain with me as a security detail as parent, media and large groups of students began coming to the location. I had all law enforcement members sign logs for ACSO deputies.
- I had this security detail keep the students secure and directed them to use the King Soopers as the evacuation location until it was determined the church directly behind the King Soopers was available for evacuation and reunification.
- I had the security detail escort the students and staff to the evacuation point and to begin
  working on a reunification plan assuring student would be identified as possible witnesses and
  to assure each student would be released only to a parent or guardian.
- I worked with Command to develop on how students would be evacuated to the church via buses and assured no unauthorized entry was being made into the church.
- Arranged to have the chapel opened for overflow and assured there was security for the chapel and investigators for interviews.
- As entry teams began clearing from the High School I directed them to the Church to assist with security and reunification.

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





On 12/13/2013 at approximately 1245 hours, all available Douglas County Deputies were requested to respond to the Arapahoe County High School for an active killer call.

I arrived at the school and teamed up with several other officers from multiple departments. We made entry on the south side into the school hallway C. The entry team I was part of cleared down the hallway clearing unlocked rooms and by passing locked rooms. We arrived outside the Science area. I observed a large pool of blood on the floor next to a wooden bench. There was a cell phone on the bench along with a back pack. On the floor next to the bench was more blood, a cell phone, and long strands of brownish colored hair. The blood trail continued down the hallway toward the cafeteria.

My entry team continued up the stairs to the second level above the science area. During the search I observed in three different classrooms approximately twenty to thirty students per classroom hiding behind desks. Once the second level was secure I assisted in gathering students into one classroom for security. While the students were exiting the class I conducted pat downs of each student for weapons and/or injuries. The order was given to evacuate the students from my area so I assisted with the evacuation down the stairs and out of the school. I then responded back to the upper level and assisted in conducting secondary and a third (slow search) of all the classrooms to include the green house.

I then went back to the area outside the science wing. I observed an empty white shotgun shell lying on the floor next to the staircase. I observed a loaded shotgun shell on the floor in the area of the doors to the Science wing. These items were guarded by officers and then traffic cones were placed over them.

I then stood guard on a hallway and an exterior door to control access in and out of the building.

I was then relieved a tactical team commander of my responsibilities and told to report to the command post. I was debriefed by command and then wrote a report reflecting my account of the incident.
