At about 11.39 A.M. on Wednesday, May 28th, 1975, a phone call was received at Police Headquarters from Mr. William SPRINGLE, the Principal of Brampton Centennial School, McMurchy Avenue South, Brampton, advising that there had been a shooting at the School. Constable Paul DRAY was advised of the call and arrived at the School at about 11.41 A.M.

Upon Constable DRAY's arrival he observed students running in all directions from the School in the area of the Portables located on the east side of the school. Constable DRAY approached the School and entered by the door located on the east side of the building, the closest to McMurchy Avenue South. He thereafter, walked down One Flight of stairs to the ground floor and made observations of this hallway. At this time he observed a body (Michael SLOBODIAN) laying face down in a pool of blood, with a rifle laying under the body. Another boy was observed laying in the doorway to Room #104, also injured. Another rifle was located approximately Five Ft. from in the centre of the hallway. At this time students were yelling and screaming and moving around the hallways. Everyone was advised

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to keep inside the Classrooms and Constable DRAY then attended to the injured parties who were scattered around the ground floor and in the First-Aid Room on the Second Level.

Shortly after this Inspector, Ian MacDONALD arrived at the Scene and assisted in caring for the injured, along with several of the School Teachers and students. Several other Officers arrived at the Scene and assisted, along with Coroner Dr. T. DAGLISH, who took charge of the injured parties and had the priority cases transported to Hospital first.

Brampton District Ambulance Service attended with several ambulances and the injured parties were all removed to Peel Memorial Hospital with a minimum of delay.

Emergency procedures were set up at Peel Memorial Hospital and all available Doctors were called to the Hospital. Emergency Surgery was conducted on two of the injured persons, Mrs. Margaret WRIGHT and John SLINGER, by a team of Surgeons. However, this was of no avail.

 Mrs. WRIGHT was pronounced dead shortly before 12.50 P.M. and John SLINGER was pronounced dead about 1.17 P.M., both by Coroner D. T. DAGLISH.  
 The body of Michael SLOBODIAN was laying in an east/west direction, face down, with the head to the east, on the ground floor hallway of the School. The following weapon was found under his body and was used to take his own life: .444 Marlin Rifle, lever-action, Model 444S, Serial No. 26053291. The following weapon was found laying in the centre of the same hallway, approximately Forty Feet East of the body, and close to the door to Room #104: .22 cal. Ruger Semi-automatic Rifle, Model 10-22, Carbine, 22LR cal. bullets, Serial No. 111-98855, with a 4X bushnell scope. A total of Thirty-nine (39) /22 cal. bullets were found in the pockets of SLOBODIAN, AND A total of Thirteen (13) .444 cal. bullets were also found in his pockets. From investigation, it has been established that a total of Fifteen (15) bullets were fired, Eight (8) from the .22 rifle, and Seven (7) from the .444 Rifle.

Post-mortem Examinations were commenced at approximately 4.00 P.M. same date, by Dr. Gordon LONGFIELD, Senior Pathologist, Peel Memorial Hospital, on the bodies of Michael SLOBODIAN, Mrs. Margaret WRIGHT and John SLINGER. The results of the Post-mortem Examinations are listed below.

John SLINGER:      Cause of Death - Exsanguination from lacerations of left lung, spleen, liver and aorta, from bullet wounds to chest and abdomen,

Margaret WRIGHT:      Cause of Death - Exsanguination from laceration to left lung, spleen, pancreas, liver and left kidney, from rifle wound to chest and abdomen,

Michael SLOBODIAN:      Cause of Death - Maceration of brain from bullet wound to the head.

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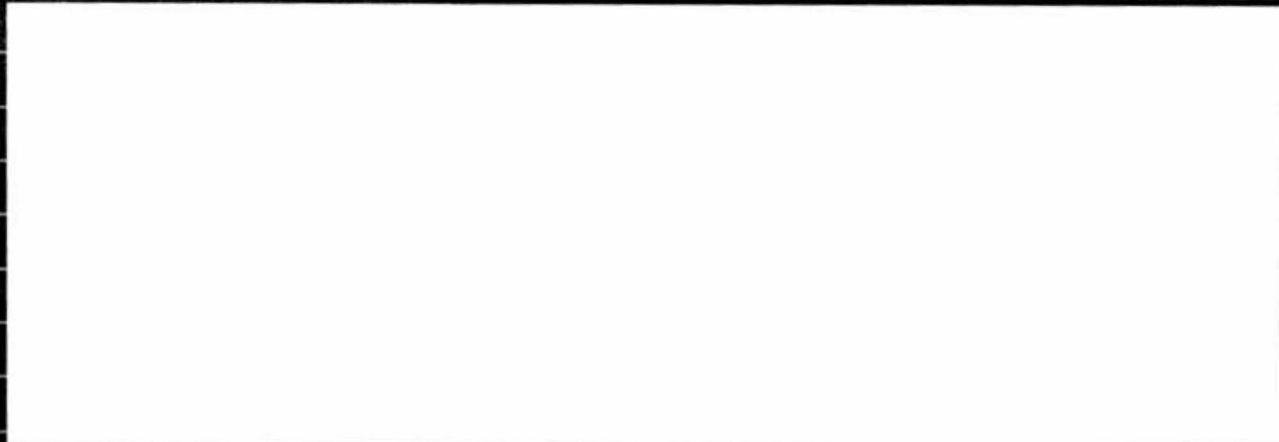

ground floor of the school, and went into the end cubicle. At this time he removed both rifles:

1. .22 cal. "RUGER" Semi-automatic with scope, Model 10-22 Carbine, 122 LR Cal.bullets, Serial No. 111-98855, with a 4x Bushnell scope.
2. .444 cal. "MARLIN" Rifle, lever action, Model .444S, Serial No. 26053291.

It is not known at this time, if the weapons were loaded or unloaded when they were removed from the guitar case.

Michael SLOBODIAN then stepped from the end cubicle and shot a total of seven times in the boys' washroom. At this time it would appear that John Berwick SLINGER was struck in the back with two .22's, and was fatally wounded. [redacted] was also struck in the back with a .22 but was able to make his own way out of the washroom into the hallway where a student pulled him into the girls' washroom a few feet away. [redacted]

[redacted] was also struck at the entrance to the boys' washroom, with the .22.

in a westerly direction. This bullet pierced the door frame on the west end of the hallway, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] all received minor injuries due to flying metal. He fired another .444 in an easterly direction thereby grazing [REDACTED] in the upper arm. This bullet continued, striking the stone wall at the east end of the hallway outside Room #106.

At this point most of the students had cleared the hallways. SLOBODIAN then ran eastwards towards Room #104 where Mrs. Margaret WRIGHT, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] waited unaware of the path of terror SLOBODIAN had carved. SLOBODIAN is described as sliding to a halt at the entrance to Room #104. He was seen to place the .22 calibre Rifle on the floor between his legs and in the centre of the doorway. He then looked Mrs. WRIGHT in the eye, and she stated, "Mike", as if about to talk to him. At this point SLOBODIAN fired the .444 from a distance of about Six Feet from Mrs. WRIGHT.

At this same moment Mrs. WRIGHT turned around and was struck in the back with

the bullet, leaving a large exit wound in the front of her chest.  
At this same moment, [redacted] fell to the floor, being struck with the same bullet. As [redacted] lay on the floor of the Classroom he heard another shot and [redacted] then screamed in terror, obviously hit. SLOBODIAN then left the Classroom, walked back westwards and then placed the .444 under the front right side of his chin and pulled the trigger, causing his own death.

When later searched, SLOBODIAN was found to have a total of Thirty-nine (39) .22 cal. bullets in his pockets, and a total of Thirteen (13) .444 cal. bullets.

The .22 holds a circular clip holding Eleven (11) bullets while the .444 holds a total of Five (5). A total of Fifteen (15) bullets were fired, Eight (8) from the .22 and Seven (7) from the .444. Three (3) .22's were found in the rifle. From the above figures it is evident that the .22 was not reloaded. However, after the .444 had been loaded, an additional two bullets had to be placed in the weapon at some point.

On Wednesday May 28, 1975 at approximately 1139 hours accompanied by Cst. J. French we were patrolling the 2116 area. At this time we responded to a radio call advising of a shooting incident at Centennial Secondary School, McMurphy Ave. S. Brampton.

On arrival I immediately entered the school via a doorway near the S.E. corner of the building. I descended a flight of stairs to the lower level where I observed two uniform constables at the doorway. I continued into the corridor and observed the Duty Inspector approximately 30' down the hallway (Insp. MacDonald) I also observed two persons lying on the floor as well as what appeared to be two rifles also on the floor.

An ambulance crew arrived on the lower floor almost simultaneously with the writer. Two persons were placed in their ambulance in my presence and I escorted this vehicle to Peel Memorial Hospital via McMurphy Ave. S. Elgin Dr. Main St. Clarence St. and Centre St. arriving at approximately 1155 hours. Mrs. Margaret WRIGHT was the first victim removed from the ambulance and rushed to Emergency Operating Room #2. At this time her identity was not known to the writer or medical staff but was only referred to as Miss K O.R. 2.

A medical team of approximately 5 Doctors and 5 Nurses immediately administered medical aid. The ranking surgeon was Dr. Wilkinson and the anesthetist was Dr. MacDonald. The writer stayed at the
