On January 13, 2011, [redacted] white, male, date of birth [redacted] social security number [redacted] who resides at [redacted] Kingman, Arizona was interviewed at his residence. Also present for the interview were DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] and DETECTIVE [redacted] of the KINGMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT (KPD). After being advised of the identities of the interviewing Agent/Detectives and the nature of the interview, he provided the following information:

It should be noted that [redacted] residence was surrounded by a chain link fence. The gates to the chain link fence were secured with padlocks. There appeared to be no way to approach the residence to make contact with the occupant(s). There was a chain link fence surrounding an adjoining lot south of [redacted] residence. There was no padlock on that gate. DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] entered the gate to hopefully make contact with the occupant(s) of the residence next door. DETECTIVE [redacted] and SA [redacted] followed. DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] stated verbally "Hello, Police" several times with no response. DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] got far enough into the adjoining lot that he was parallel to the back porch of the [redacted] residence. SA [redacted] overheard DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] state "here we go" indicating that someone had exited the rear of the [redacted] residence. SA [redacted] observed a heavy set white, male, wearing nothing but his underwear. The older white male was later identified as [redacted]. SA [redacted] did not observe the right side of [redacted] body from SA [redacted] vantage point. DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] then stated "put the gun down" at which point SA [redacted] and DETECTIVE [redacted] obtained cover behind an older model pick up truck. Once behind the pick up truck, SA [redacted] observed that [redacted] had a handgun in his right hand that he was holding down to his side. DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] identified himself to [redacted] and advised him that we just wanted to talk to him. [redacted] then stated he was going inside to put the gun away, and to bring his five dogs inside the house from the yard.

[redacted] exited the residence a short time later, without the gun, and with clothes on. [redacted] invited SA [redacted] DETECTIVE SERGEANT [redacted] and DETECTIVE [redacted] into the residence. The residence was unkept and littered with trash and debris. [redacted] escorted us into the living room, while his wife was on the telephone attempting to contact [redacted] attorney. SA _____ asked _____ about his disability. _____ stated that he has a back injury which requires him to take pain medication. SA _____ asked _____ if he owned any other weapons besides the handgun. _____ stated he didn't have to answer that question. _____ then volunteered that he is a gun collector. SA _____ asked _____ if he collected handguns or long guns. _____ stated he did not feel comfortable answering that question.

_____ started initiating a conversation with the KPD Detectives regarding the police not doing anything about the individuals that had been breaking into his yard. SA _____ again asked _____ if he had any intention of harming anyone, and he stated no.
