

THE TABLE WAS POSITIONED AT THE CENTER OF ABOUT FIVE ADDITIONAL TABLES, IN THE ROW CLOSEST TO THE EDGE OF THE PATIO. SHE WAS SEATED FACING EAST TOWARDS N 75 AVE, WHILE WAS FACING TOWARDS THE EXTERIOR OF THE SNACK LOUNGE. SOMETIME AROUND 0750 TO 0755 HOURS SHE HEARD A LOUD SOUND. THOUGHT THE SOUND WAS A TABLE BUT SHE FELT IT WAS A GUNSHOT AND ALSO SAW SOME SMOKE RISING JUST BEYOND THE PATIO.

AT ABOUT 1320 HOURS WE TALKED WITHIN THE OFFICE OF SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, LOCATED WITHIN THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE OF THE SCHOOL. PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
ON 02-12-2016 PRIOR TO THE START OF CLASSES HE WAS WITHIN
