### NARRATIVE

ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2014, AT 923 HOURS, WHILE IN UNIFORM ON DUTY IN LAS CRUCES, NEW MEXICO, I RESPONDED TO THE LOBBY AT THE LAS CRUCES POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE CONTACT WITH MYRON MAY.

MR. MAY ADVISED ME THAT HE WANTED TO DOCUMENT AN INFORMATION REPORT IN REFERENCE TO SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES AT HIS ADDRESS LOCATED AT 251 ROADRUNNER PARKWAY, SPACE 1403. HE ADVISED ME THAT OVER THE PAST TWO WEEKS HE WAS ALMOST CERTAIN THAT THERE WAS CAMERA SOMEWHERE LOCATED IN THE INTERIOR OF HIS RESIDENCE. HE BELIEVES HE WAS BEING WATCHED AND OBSERVED. HE STATED THAT HE CAN CONSTANTLY HEAR VOICES COMING THROUGH THE WALLS SPECIFICALLY TALKING ABOUT ACTIONS HE WAS DOING.

AT THIS POINT, I EXPLAINED TO HIM WHAT EXACTLY HE WAS TALKING ABOUT TO WHICH HE STATED THAT FOR INSTANCE LAST NIGHT HE PROCEEDED TO DRAW HIMSELF A BUBBLE BATH. HE STATED ONCE HE GOT OUT THE BUBBLE BATH, HE PROCEEDED TO GO PUT LOTION ON. AT WHICH POINT, HE SPECIFICALLY STATED HE HEARD VOICES SAY DID YOU SEE THAT, HE NEVER PUTS LOTION ON.

AT THIS POINT, I ASKED HIM THERE WAS ANYBODY WHO WOULD WANT TO BE CONDUCTING SURVEILLANCE ON HIM OR IF HE HAD ANY PREVIOUS INCIDENTS WITH ANYBODY TO WHICH HE STATED NO. I ALSO ASKED HIM IF THERE WAS ANY WORK RELATED INCIDENTS, WHICH MIGHT LEAD TO HIM BEING OBSERVED. HE STATED NO AGAIN.

I THEN PROCEEDED TO ADVISE HIM THAT THERE WAS NO MUCH THAT I COULD DO OTHER THAN SUGGEST HE TALK TO THE PROPERTY OWNER ABOUT POSSIBLY OBTAINING A DIFFERENT APARTMENT TO SEE MIGHT ALLEVIATE HIS SITUATION. HE ADVISED ME THAT HE WAS GOING TO HIRE A PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION MORE THOROUGHLY; HOWEVER, HE STATED HE JUST WANTED THIS INCIDENT DOCUMENTED. I PROCEEDED TO PROVIDE HIM WITH A CASE NUMBER. THIS ENDS MY INVOLVEMENT IN THIS INCIDENT.
