a) Five (5) of the thirteen fibres removed from the knife and inside the knife sheath are similar to those employed in the construction of the jacket, exhibit 63, and could have originated from that source or from some other source possessing similar characteristics.

b) Cuts of recent origin are present in the following exhibits as indicated:

Exhibit 63 - Jacket (outer fabric): 9 cuts
Exhibit 63 - Jacket (inner lining): 10 cuts
Exhibit 64 - Blouse : 9 cuts

Exhibit 65 - Back portion of brassiere: 2 cuts

The cuts present in exhibits 63 and 64 are situated within an area of the central back of each garment bounded vertically from approximately 125 mm. (5") below the collarline to 300 mm. (12") below the collarline, and horizontally from below the left armpit area across the back approximately 400 mm. (16").

Nine (9) of the ten cuts present in the jacket lining bear a close relationship with regard to size, shape, and relative location to those present in the jacket outer fabric. A tenth cut present in the lining may have resulted from a fold in the lining fabric.

Eight (8) of the nine cuts present in the blouse bear a close relationship to those present in the jacket outer fabric. A ninth cut is displaced approximately 130 mm. (5") from a corresponding cut in the outer jacket fabric.

The cuts present in the above four garments are consistant in size, shape, and relative location with having originated from nine penetrations.

- c) The thirty (30) cuts present in the articles of clothing, exhibits 63, 64 and 65 are consistant with having originated, from the knife, exhibit G, or some other object possessing similar characteristics.
- d) The sixteen (16) human scalp hairs removed from exhibits C,D,E,F, and V are dissimilar to those removed from the jacket, exhibit $63./M_{\odot}$

e) The fragments of brassiere, exhibits 11 and 65, originated from the same garment.

The two ends of the portion of brassiere, exhibit 65 (one of which was physically matched to exhibit 11) are indicative of cuts of recent origin.

f) The charred textile fragments present in exhibit 19 are a PLAIN WEAVE cotton fabric, and are dissimilar to those fabrics employed in the construction of exhibit 63, jacket, exhibit 64, blouse, and exhibits 65 and 11, brassiere.

REMARKS:

- a) The phrase "cut of recent origin" means that the garment has not been worn excessively or laundered since the cut occurred.

DATA:

The exhibits were examined for the above PURPOSES and the results recorded.

CONCLUSIONS:

- i) The four (4) expended shotshells exhibits M, N, O and P were fired in the shotqun exhibit H. The primer is missing from the shotshell exhibit #19 and there were no impressions remaining on its surface for examination purposes after it had been burned. The missing primer from exhibit #19 is indicative of this shotshell having been subjected to heat while in an unsupported condition.
- ii) The unfired round of shotgun ammunition exhibit L was chambered and extracted at least three (3) times in/from the shotgun exhibit H.
- iii) The lead alloy pellets exhibits I, J, R, #20, #62, #74, C-1 and those received on 12 November 1975 are consistent in size and weight with #5 shot pellets.
- iv) If the shot causing the punctures in the jacket exhibit K was fired from the shotgun exhibit H using ammunition similar to exhibits L, M, N, O and P then it was probably fired at a distance not less than twenty (20') feet and not more than thirty-two (32') feet, with a range of approximately twenty-six (26') feet between the muzzle of the firearm and the jacket being the most consistent with the pattern on the jacket.
- v) The burned portion of shotgun barrel exhibit #88 and the barrel on the shotgun exhibit H can neither be identified nor eliminated as having been at one time one (1) continuous piece. The hacksaw/blade combinations exhibits #77 and #78 have not been identified as having cut the barrel exhibit #88 or the barrel on exhibit H.

REMARKS:

- i) Exhibit #19, the burned shotshell base portion, was turned over to C/M G.R. CARROLL, Hair and Fibre Section, for examination on 6 November 1975.
- ii) Exhibits C-1, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, R, #19, #20, #62, #74, #77, #78, #88 and the pellets received on 12 November 1975 are being retained pending further instructions. Partially completed diary dated reply forms are attached hereto.

- .b) The debris in exhibit 52 was examined microscopically and samples of what appeared to be plastic were analyzed and compared with the plastic from exhibit 14 using an Infrared (diamond window) technique.
- c) Exhibit 87 was examined microscopically.
- d) Exhibits C, D, E, F and V were searched for the possible presence of lipstick smears.

- CONCLUSIONS:a) Exhibits 1 and 2 (tin cans), exhibit 5 (debris from the night table), exhibit 6 (papers) and exhibit D ("Jeans") were all found to contain traces of Naphtha, a light petroleum product which could be used as a fire accelerant.
 - b) Exhibit 3 (tin can) and exhibit 8 (bed clothes) were both found to contain traces of gasoline, which can be used as a fire accelerant.
 - c) The plastic-like debris from exhibit 52 and plastic exhibit 14 were found to be chemically similar and consistent with thin film polyethylene.
