12/01/1992: Family, along with WONG, re-locate to Johnson City NY. During his time in Johnson City, WONG works at various manufacturing jobs locally [REDACTED]

10/02/1995: Officially changes name from LINH VOONG to JIVERLY A. WONG.

11/17/1995: WONG becomes a Naturalized US Citizen.

06/26/1996: WONG submits application to Broome County Sheriffs Dept. for a pistol permit.

06/02/1997: WONG granted a pistol permit.

Summer of 1999: WONG establishes an address in Huntington Park CA.

12/23/1999: WONG marries [REDACTED] they reside in California. In California, WONG gets a job as a sushi delivery driver for the next 7 years [REDACTED]

05/16/2005: [REDACTED] formally leaves WONG (back to NY), files for and is eventually granted divorce (07/21/2006).

2006-2007: Sometime over the course of this period, WONG loses his job as a delivery person.

August 2007: After being refused benefits in CA, WONG returns to the Broome County area, and applies for benefits here.

WONG eventually is employed at [REDACTED]

03/21/2008: WONG purchases .45 caliber Berretta hand gun from [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] (gun eventually used in Civic Association event).

November 2008: [REDACTED] closes its local manufacturing facility, leaving
WONG un-employed.

01/21/2009: WONG goes to the Broome County Employment Office for
assistance in finding employment. He is introduced to the
concept of improving his communication skills through classes
at the American Civic Association, 131 Front St. Binghamton
NY. He takes an entry level exam at the Civic Association and
begins taking classes there. He was determined to be at an inter-
mediate level, having good receptive language skills. He was
considered a quiet student who didn't stand out. Eventually
WONG was dropped from the program for a lack of attendance.

02/04/2009: WONG purchases a 9MM Beretta handgun from [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] (gun eventually used in Civic Association event).
Over the course of February 2009, WONG purchases the bulk
of his ammunition at [REDACTED]

03/30/2009: WONG goes to the Department of Social Services and applies
for Medicare. A second interview for WONG is scheduled at
DSS for 12:30 PM, 04/03/2009.

04/03/2009: At approximately 10:30 AM., WONG goes to the Civic
Association and proceeds to shoot a total of 16 individuals.
The individuals were comprised of 2 staff members and 14
students, killing 13 before turning his gun on and killing him-
self.

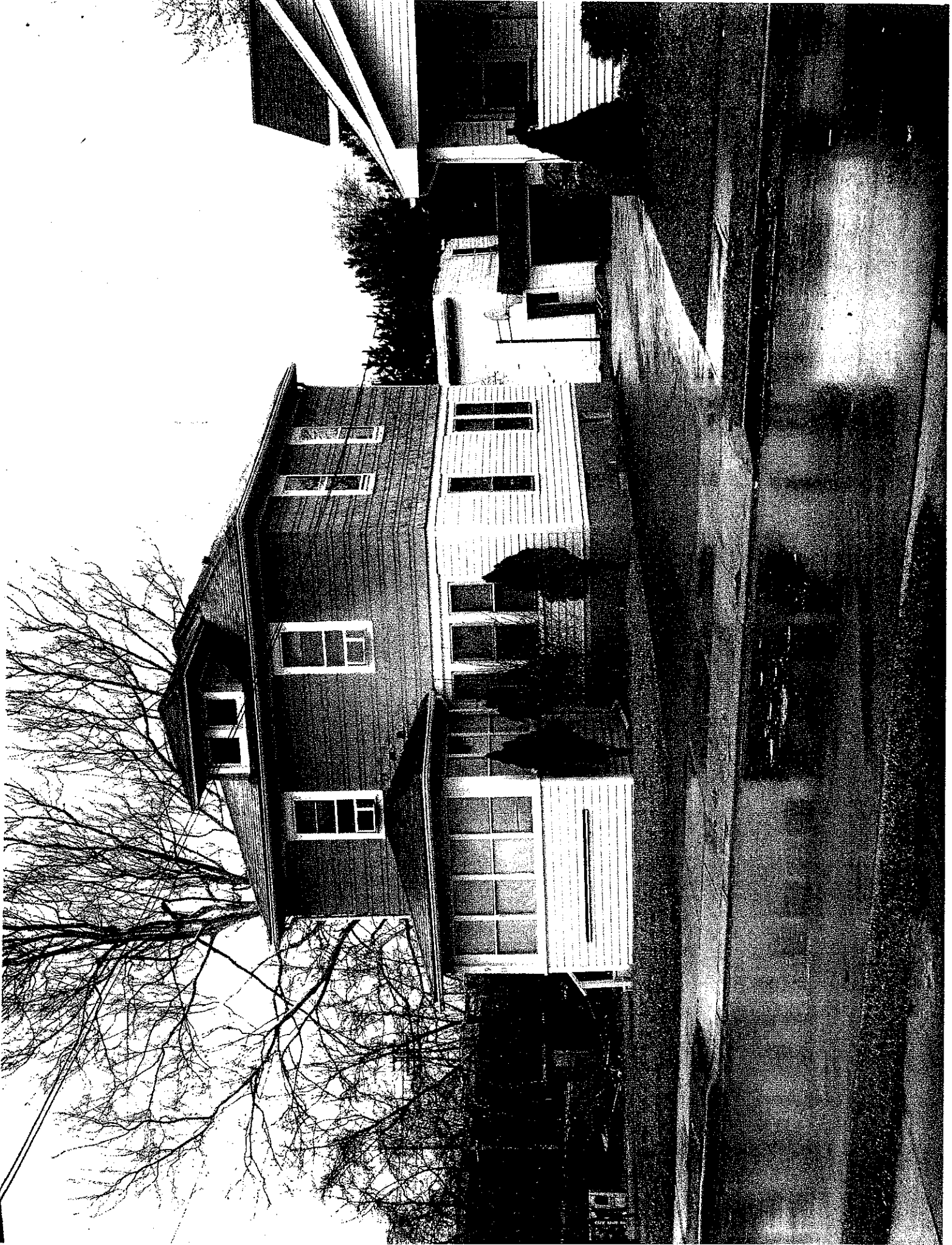

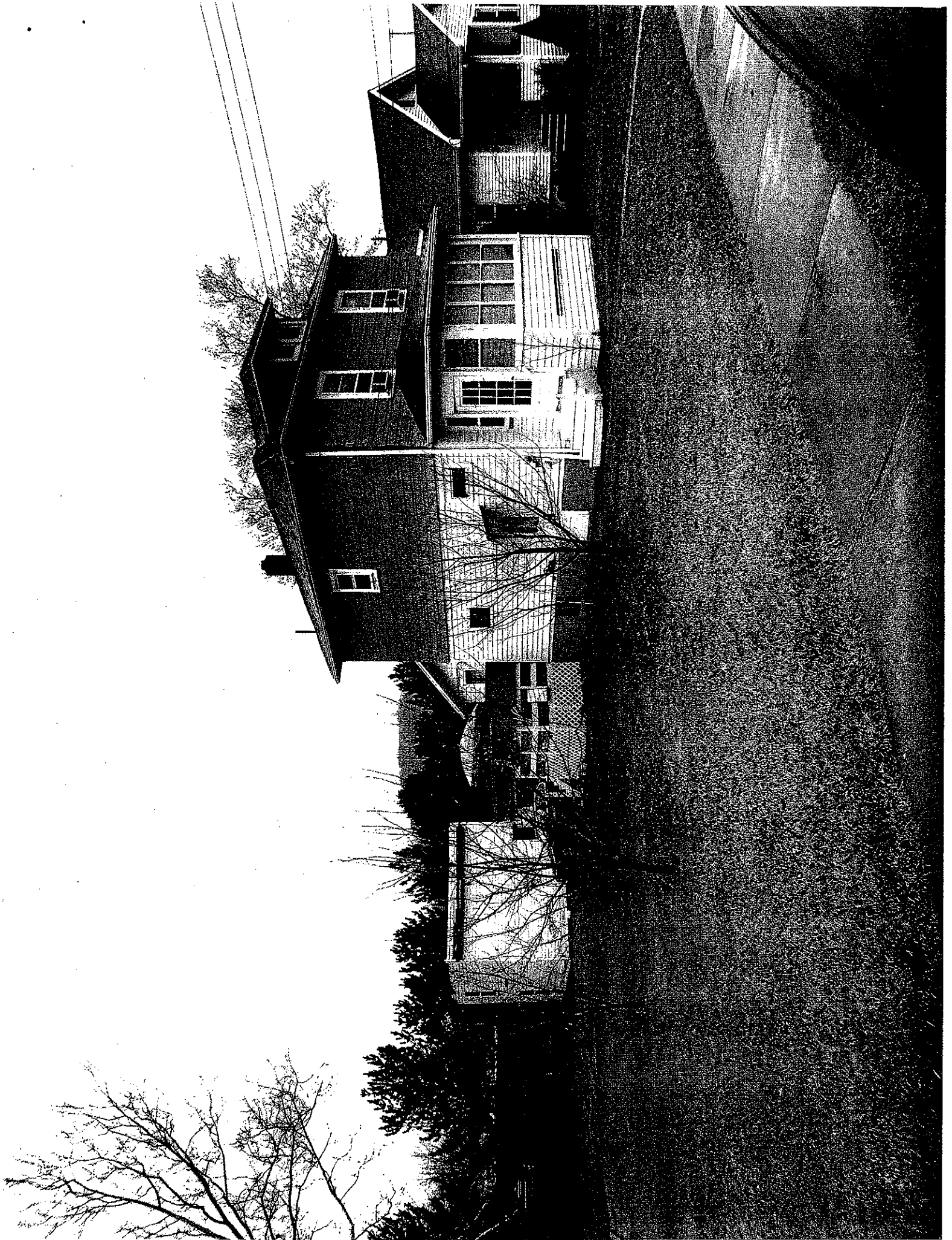

- 1) **Investigator C. Minor** being duly sworn, deposes and says:
That I have been a police officer in the City of Binghamton Police Department for approximately **9 1/2** years and that I am currently assigned to the Detective Division with the rank of Investigator. One of the principal functions of the Detective Division is the investigations of violations of New York State's Penal Laws. Prior to holding my present position, I was a member of the Binghamton Police Department Special Investigation Unit. During my tenure with that unit I have assisted in the execution of more than a 100 Search Warrants. I have interviewed and worked with many types of sources to include, confidential and reliable informants. As a member of the Detective Division, I have been involved in numerous felony investigations which resulted in the arrest and conviction of numerous individuals.
- 2) That, as is more particularly set forth herein, your Affiant is informed and believes that property consisting of the following:

Any firearm including but not limited to handguns, revolvers, rifle, shotgun, ammunition, laser sight or any other firearm accessory, and any instrument readily capable of causing injury or death to a human being.

Any notes, records, writings, diaries, correspondence, photographs, business records, personal papers or other documentation which show a relationship or affiliation with another person(s) involving their activities, as related to the investigation into the shooting of multiple persons at the American Civic Association, 131 Front St., Binghamton, New York

Any cellular phones which may be examined for stored data including phone books and call logs.

Any computers, hardware, and peripheral devices, including but not limited to computer circuit boards and devices connected thereto, computer cases and hardware contained therein. Any computer software including discs, manuals, instructions and containers for same. Any media used for storing any type of computer data, including but not limited compact discs, hard drives, portable drives, DVD disks and floppy diskettes.

that may be presently found in the following premises outbuilding and vehicle(s):

9/11 TAYLOR ST, TOWN OF UNION, NEW YORK. 9/11 TAYLOR ST, TOWN OF UNION, NEW YORK, IS A SINGLE FAMILY HOME, DARK BLUE ON TOP, LIGHT BLUE ON BOTTOM WITH AN ENCLOSED PORCH, LOCATED BETWEEN RIVERSIDE DR AND THE DEAD END. THE HOME IS LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STREET LOCATED BETWEEN NUMBER 3 AND 15 TAYLOR;

AND

A TWO STORY DETACHED GARAGE, WHITE IN COLOR, LOCATED DIRECTLY BEHIND 11 TAYLOR ST, TOWN OF UNION, NEW YORK;

AND

1993 TOYOTA CAMRY, GREEN IN COLOR BEARING NEW YORK REGISTRATION, [REDACTED] NEW YORK, CURRENTLY LOCATED AT THE AMERICAN CIVIC ASSOCIATION, 131 FRONT ST, BINGHAMTON.

- 3) The basis of your Affiant's information and grounds for his belief is set forth as follows:
- A. On April 3, 2009 at approximately 1030 hrs, Broome County communications dispatched officers to the American Civic Association, located at 131 Front Street in the City of Binghamton, for a report of shots fired. Upon arrival officers received information that numerous shots had been fired by an unknown gunman, and that there were numerous victims inside the building. Responding officers established a perimeter around the building, and in doing so, they located a 1993 Toyota Camry, green in color, New York registration [REDACTED] parked against the back door of the Civic Center, in an apparent attempt to block people from exiting the building.
 - B. Officers further examined this vehicle and found it to be locked, but were able to visually observe a fire arm laser sight and book bag inside the vehicle. DMV check of the vehicle showed that it was registered to an Asian male, [REDACTED]

- c. Further information was received from callers inside the building, that the suspected shooter was an Asian male approximately 6' tall, thin build, wearing dark glasses, blue jeans and a bright green coat.
- D. I was advised that Inv. Koop of the New York State Police, responded to [REDACTED] and spoke to an asian female identified as [REDACTED] the sister of Jiverly Antares Wong. This female confirmed that her brother Jiverly Wong, was driving the 1993 Toyota, color green, and that her brother, was attending class at the Civic Center this date. Further interview of the female confirmed that [REDACTED] is the primary residence of Jiverly Antares Wong.
- E. A check of Broome county, Pistol permit records show that Jiverly Wong has several handguns registered to him in County of Broome. A copy of Wongs Broome county pistol permit is attached to and made part of this application.
- 4) Based on my experience and training, as well as with speaking to experienced investigators/detectives, I have become familiar with the ways of individuals who engage in crimes of violence involving **person(s) and property**, and that individuals commonly follow a similar modus operandi.

Your Affiant is familiar with how many crimes (ie., homicide, kidnapping, rape, assault, robbery, burglary, larceny, etc..) involve contact of the physical surroundings of the crime scene and the perpetrator(s) and at times, this contact involves force. Commonly, this contact results in items and traces of evidentiary material being transferred to and from the crime scene and to and from locations familiar to the perpetrator(s).

Furthermore, these items and traces of evidentiary material are commonly left at crime scenes or carried off by perpetrator(s) intentionally or unknowingly and that the items and traces of evidentiary material may link the perpetrator(s) with the crime. Commonly, these items and traces of evidentiary material being transferred can be in the manner of stolen items, clothing, tools, weapons, impressions, fingerprints, bullets, fired casings, gun shot residue, bodily fluids, hair, fibers, dirt, soils, particles, etc...

- 5) That, for the following reasons, your Affiant believes that a Search Warrant issued pursuant to this application should authorize the seizure of certain articles described in section 2 of this application. Based upon your Affiant's training and experience as a Police Officer, whose primary area of responsibilities are that of the investigations of violations of the New York State Penal Law, he is of the opinion that the aforementioned types of items and traces of

evidentiary material are usually present at the types of locations sought to be searched in this warrant and your Affiant believes that these items are not the type normally disposed of and can be found at the locations searched.

- 6) That, for the following reasons, your Affiant believes that a Search Warrant issued pursuant to this application should authorize its execution at **any time of the day or night**, in the event the evidence located can lead to the identification of others who may have been involved or who may have information concerning the incident.

Based on your Affiant's training and experience as an Investigator assigned to the Binghamton Police Detective Division, and whose primary duties are that of enforcing violations of New York State Penal Law, your Affiant is the opinion that items described to be seized could be destroyed or removed from locations sought to be searched resulting in the loss of valuable evidence if not seized forthwith. Your Affiant is of the opinion that illegal activities, including but not limited to destruction of evidence are rarely confined to the hours between 6 AM and 9 PM.

- 7) That, for the following reasons, your Affiant believes that a Search Warrant issued pursuant to this application should authorize its execution with the necessity of the officer executing the same giving notice of their authority and purpose prior to entering the subject **premise and vehicle(s)**:
- 8) That no prior application for a Search Warrant involving the facts alleged herein has been made to any Court.

WHEREFORE, your Affiant respectfully requests that the Court, pursuant to the authority vested in it under Article 690 of the Criminal Procedure Law of the State of New York, issue a Search Warrant, in the form annexed, which Search Warrant would:

Authorize a search of the **premise and vehicle(s)** in **section 2** above;

Authorize the seizure of property of the kind and character described herein as may be found therein upon execution of said Search Warrant;

Authorize, for the reasons set fourth in **section 6** above, that the Search Warrant may be executed at **any time of the day or night**;

Authorize, for the reasons set fourth in **section 7** above, that the Search Warrant may be executed with notice and purpose being announced prior to making entry to searching **premises or person(s)** described in section 2 above.
